Type of government: parliamentary constitutional monarchy

Current leader: divided into 3 branches → Executive Branch (King Felipe VI and President of the Gov of Spain Pedro Sánchez Pérez-Castejón), Legislative Branch (Senate and Congress of Deputies), Judicial Branch (Supreme Court)

Number of inhabitants: 47 222 613

Influence on a world scale: average

Major strengths: high-income core EU economy; diversified trade portfolio; continental tourism

Major weaknesses: high government spending and debt; prone to political financing corruption; pollution of the Mediterranean Sea from raw sewage

Main allies: France, Germany, US

Main enemies: UK, Portugal, Morocco, Russia

Major conflicts and tensions it is/has been involved in: disapproval of UK's sovereignty proposal/Conflict of territory with Morocco

Portugal does not recognise Spanish sovereignty over the territory of Olivenza
