

Tips: How to be a prepared delegate for ISYMUN?



DON'T FORGET TO BRING YOUR CLAUSE ALREADY TYPED ON A USB KEY!!!

- use the research reports provided by the ISYMUN team only as a main basis for your work (*to get some new ideas of possible resolutions, to check previous resolutions that has already been voted on your subject at the UN...*)
- make sure that you have a good understanding of the stakes and issues raised by your subject (*do additional researches and define key terms if needed...*)
- find information about your country international position on the debated topic (*if it is part of an international organization, signed agreements and treaties, its status at the UN, alliances, tensions or conflicts with other countries...*)
- learn about the situation in your country (*policy, political regime and leaders, economic situation, people's life conditions, culture and religion...*)
- get familiar with potential actions led by your country and the main events that may have happened around the world linked to your topic (*look at the news very often, study the laws adopted by your country...*)
- try to elaborate strong and persuasive arguments or even counter arguments by choosing appropriated examples (*such as statistics, quotes,*

you should have as much knowledge about your country than on the others...)

- be completely aware of the major MUN rules (*all reminded on our website*) and take care to never be disrespectful towards other delegations (*notably no speech at the first person, no war declaration, write a clause following the established model and read it before you present it at the floor...*)
